LAST EMPIRE saved ground, prompted the pace, secured command after a half mile and pulled away through the stretch under urging. GIANT PATRIOT stalked the pace, circled the turn, chased the winner and was second best. KADDISH chased the pace, came into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed rally. ASYLUM saved ground and weakened. GRESHAM PALACE , along the rail on the backstretch, eased out on the turn, swung to the five path near the quarter pole and failed to be a factor. OUR HAE , rail stretch, was outrun. BLUE TAPE showed speed in the two path, was done on the turn and stopped in the stretch.
