LOOSE N CAPABLE dueled three wide around the turn, gained a clear advantage in midstretch then dug in late to prevail. GREAT AZTEC , four wide around the turn, chased the winner and closed the gap late. HOUSTON BULL lacked speed, hugged the rail around the turn, chased the winner and flattened out. FOREST KING stalked the pace, raced in the three path behind horses on the turn and lacked the needed late response. SPECIAL EXCHANGE , five wide around the turn, was no factor. NO CROSSING LANE dueled two wide on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. KAPOK trailed.
