Footnotes

GILHOOLY'S SUPER prompted the pace three wide, cut into the leader's margin after a half mile, took command three sixteenths out, lugged in under left handed pressure when going clear a furlong out, widened from there and was kept to steady pressure until late. FERRY MUSIC , outrun early, circled four to five wide into the stretch, finished up willingly and edged WHATABOOTIE in the final strides to earn the place. WHATABOOTIE in close attendance while saving ground, shifted out four wide past the furlong marker, finished with interest but was edged for second. PURELY LOVE gained command soon after the break, set a solid pace two wide, took pressure entering the lane, was overtaken in upper stretch then tired leaving the furlong pole. MARGARET MARY , jostled at the break, saved ground while outrun into the turn, angled out for the drive but failed to threaten. CLOSING BID bobbled inward and bumped soundly with MARGARET MARY, hustled up between rivals soon after, was hard used chasing three wide around the turn then faltered in upper stretch. FEISTY ANGELINA , between rivals early, chased around the turn and dropped back after a half mile.
