Footnotes

GOODNESS GREATNESS settled off the rail and inside a rival, advanced mid turn, angled out six wide for the drive, closed relentlessly under stout left handed encouragement, caught OUTSIDE LANE inside the sixteenth marker and forged ahead in the final yards. OUTSIDE LANE rated three wide in a stalking position, lodged a bid near the half mile marker, dueled around the far turn, drew clear nearing the quarter pole, drifted out when widening a bit in upper stretch, was straightened away while clear a furlong out, finished gamely but just could not withstand the winner. CAKE WALK sprinted clear early and angled towards the inside, was overtaken around the far turn, vied inside the leader leaving the three eighths pole while under a ride then gradually gave way through the final furlong. COAL VALLEY lacked speed, had some belated action well out in the track but failed to menace. SUSAN KARAN stalked the pace four wide and faded. APROMISEBYTOMORROW was outrun. SPIRITUAL SPIRITS broke slowly, saved ground and weakened.
