Footnotes

COVE STAR rated three wide in a forward position, advanced in hand nearing the lane, took over when roused three sixteenths out, kicked clear nearing the furlong pole, swerved out briefly near the sixteenth pole, was quickly righted and dug in under a drive. GOLD CASING was steadied back along the rail nearing the far turn, angled out and advanced four wide under rating approaching the lane, shifted out wider in upper stretch, closed menacingly in mid stretch, steadied briefly a sixteenth out then failed to sustain his run. MONEY FOR LOVE, unhurried early while off the rail, made progress four wide into the lane then lacked the needed finish. AWESOME RHYTHM settled off the rail, angled in near the quarter pole, shifted back out a bit in mid stretch then finished willing inside MONEY FOR LOVE. GOTTA BELIEVE ME cleared early, set the pace along the rail to upper stretch then surrendered through the last eighth. RASCAL CAT, between rivals early, edged closer after a half mile, made a run at the leader mid turn, chased into the stretch and tired. FIRST AND BAY stalked off the rail, was ridden along past the half mile marker, failed to respond and tired leaving the three eighths pole. REHOBOTH was pulled up early and walked off. There was a stewards inquiry and objection by the rider of GOLD CASING against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch but no action was taken
