LONESOME SOUND, under a snug hold early, angled out leaving the three-eighths pole, advanced quickly five wide nearing the lane, lodged a bid in mid stretch then edged clear under a drive. EARTH TO JACKIE, between horses the final turn, steadied behind rivals nearing the lane, swung out in upper stretch and closed gamely. INDIAN HEAD PENNY prompted the pace in hand, moved up three wide into the far turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch then gave way. COMELY COMET void of early speed, swung out wide in mid stretch and closed belatedly. MISSY DEAR, never far back towards the inside, advanced between rivals into the lane and flattened out. ARDEN HOUSE five wide into the first turn, moved between rivals near the quarter pole and faded. PROUD RUN, broke in the air, stalked the pace while three to four wide, advanced mildly nearing the quarter pole and faded in the drive. WASSILLA in mid pack while three wide, lacked a closing response. VICTORY CHIME never fired. SHE'S NO TEN prompted the pace, gained a short lead on the final turn then tired leaving the eighth pole. PRIVATEERS BAY made the early pace along the rail and faltered. ADMONISH, wide early, faltered.
