Footnotes

OUT OF THE FIRE moved up four wide around the far turn, swept to command near the three sixteenths pole, was under vigorous rousing and eagerly drew away. COULDAWOULDASHOULD saved ground setting the pace, weakened and drifted out near the sixteenth pole. GOLDSOME saved ground, eased off the rail in upper stretch and was lightly steadied on the heels of COULDAWOULDASHOULD near the sixteenth pole. HEROIC ROYAL , rank approaching the first turn, was steadied in tight quarters on the first turn, raced inside horses and lacked the needed rally. COUNT TO SEVEN , very wide the far turn, was not a threat. RUNNING GAME , shuffled back soon after the break, floated to the six path leaving the far turn then passed tired horses. BACKDOOR STRIKE , in close quarters leaving the starting gate, was not a factor. SMART OWNER chased the pace outside COULDAWOULDASHOULD and faltered in upper stretch. SUNINYOUREYES , three wide both turns, stalked the pace and faltered approaching the stretch. DAN'S DAN dropped back.
