ROMAN RATING bore out leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn, eased out in mid stretch, closed and drew out. GASTON sped to the front, set the pace slightly off the rail and was no match for the winner. OH SAY LOU raced three wide around the turn and finished willingly. ONE MORE POWER, steadied in close quarters soon after the start, raced forwardly to mid stretch then weakened. WOLF TALK, pinched back leaving the starting gate, was no factor and raced six wide into the stretch. DEODAR broke slowly and raced seven wide entering the lane. GOLDMINER'S DREAM was no factor. SIR WEXFORD, no factor, raced five wide entering the stretch. WHY CHANGE raced off the rail and gave way. WISE DUSTY, fanned wide turning for home, fell back. An objection by the rider of ONE MORE POWER against the winner for alleged interference leaving the starting gate was not allowed.
