Footnotes

VARBOROUGH tracked the pace four wide, moved to a short lead just past the three sixteenths marker, was joined from the inside by OIL RIG, duelled with that rival to the wire and prevailed in a extended drive. OIL RIG bobbed inward and bumped with YES HE DID, recovered to press the pace three to four wide outside SMOKIN AMMO, moved between rivals to draw on near even terms in upper stretch, battled gamely inside the winner through the final furlong and just missed in a sharp effort. SERVICE FOR TEN stumbled at the break to be away slowly, was taken to rate while saving ground into the turn, came under pressure three furlongs out, shifted out four to five wide advancing into the stretch, worked between rivals in mid stretch and sustained his run to be gaining at the wire. FLASHY BULLET, hustled along off the pace while removed from the inside, worked outward five to six wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed finish. YES HE DID bobbed at the break and was bumped, lagged back, raced very wide in the drive, had some belated action but was never a threat. SHISHA angled to the rail advancing nearing the half mile marker, stalked the pace to the head of the lane then faded in the final furlong. AVENUESOFNEWYORK stalked the pace between rivals and weakened through the drive. SMOKIN AMMO was sent to the front, set the pace three wide to the head of the lane, was headed near the three sixteenths marker, held well to the eighth pole then tired.
