Footnotes

IDLE TALK rated kindly off the leader, moved three wide to challenge in upper stretch, overtook I'M ENGAGED a furlong out, kicked clear then held firm under solid handling. MARCIE LEE , four wide under rating off the pace, gradually gained into the far turn, circled four to five wide into the stretch and finished well to be gaining at the wire. I'M ENGAGED , three wide to clear, set a rated pace towards the inside, drifted out a touch entering the stretch, dug in when challenged leaving the three sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly the final yards. CHAMPAGNE DANCER rated in good position early, dropped to the rail leaving the far turn, came under pressure after six furlongs but went evenly in the drive. DRUID DANCER stalked the pace three wide and faded. SIMPLE SONGS was steadied briefly soon after the break, angled out near the half mile marker but failed to respond. LUCKY LASS , three wide into the far turn, had no rally when called upon. WACKED OUT settled in mid pack early, dropped back towards the inside leaving the far turn, angled out in upper stretch but came up empty. PINK PALLET lagged well back, came six wide for the drive but failed to rally. CELTIC CROSS saved ground while forwardly placed for five furlongs, tired.
