STONE FACE settled off the rail, advanced four wide into the lane, closed steadily under right handed pressure and got up in the final yards. ONEMOREFASHION took some early pressure inside, moved clear into the turn, remained clear past the eighth pole, had her rider lose his whip in the final jumps and just failed to last. SHE CAN PUNCH , rank at the break, raced four wide down the backstretch, advanced three wide mid turn, chased the leader into the lane then came up empty. MOJO GAL stalked the pace while saving ground and dropped back around the turn. PLATINUM SKY , rank at the break, stalked the early pace three wide and dropped back. MISS STACK , urged inside into the turn, failed to respond. SHEZADIOS pressed the early pace two wide and faltered.
