Footnotes

OIL RIG set the pace near the rail, opened up in upper stretch and held sway under brisk rousing. RIGHT ON TIME , in the five path between horses entering the stretch, rallied. VOTE YES FOR LOVE , floated to the six path turning for home, rallied. E OR bobbled at the break, ranged up three wide on the turn, had aim on the lead in upper stretch and gave way late. JAKE'S LIL MAN saved ground on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, worked between horses and passed tired ones. THE CALLER , steadied leaving the starting gate, raced inside horses on the turn, swung to the four path entering the stretch then failed to rally. THEMANINTHEGLASS , in the two path on the turn, drifted wide in midstretch then passed tired horses. THREEANDDONEDAN showed speed along the rail then weakened after being steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch. GO SIX GO prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened. FEDERAL HILL dropped back and drifted to the six path in upper stretch.
