SOUTHWESTERN HEAT quickly went clear, set a rapid pace, raced three wide in upper stretch, continued to widen to mid stretch then held a safe margin under a drive. JACOB'S RUN , rated back early, angled out seven wide for the drive, closed willingly and earned the place. NORJAC , outrun early, advanced five wide into the lane, finished gamely but missed the place inside of JACOB'S RUN. EMISHI WARRIOR chased the pace three wide between rivals and lacked a solid response. HEART THROBBIN' settled early, angled out leaving the three eighths pole, made a mild four wide run between rivals nearing the quarter pole then faded in the drive. BET A BUCK , four wide into the turn, chased the winner and weakened in the final furlong. ON THE VINEYARD chased the pace inside and faded. RAVALO , two wide between rivals chasing the pace, steadied when in a bit tight entering the lane and gave way.
