Footnotes

CASI CIELO stalked the pace inside horses, advanced in the two path on the far turn, closed steadily outside MAKE THEM BREAK and was along in time. MAKE THEM BREAK , quickly clear, set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. SAFE LANDING stalked the pace racing inside horses, eased off the rail approaching the sixteenth pole and rallied. HAM AND ERNIE hopped at the break, was two wide on the first turn, moved up wide around the far turn and failed to sustain his bid. TRI POWER lacked speed, raced along the rail through the stretch and passed tired horses. BARTLETTS , rated back early, raced in the three path on the first turn, was four wide on the far turn and came up empty in the drive. MEDIA SPEED , wide both turns, was outrun. JOHNNY TORNADO , no factor, gave way after six furlongs. INTO THE WIND , five wide the first turn, chased the pace, raced in the three path the far turn and faltered.
