### Footnotes

FAVORED LADY advanced in the three path on the far turn, secured command in upper stretch, drifted in and drew away under brisk urging. PEBBLE TO A PEARL , well off the rail, disputed the pace to upper stretch then tired. ABOUND , three wide the first turn, stalked the pace, swung to the four path entering the stretch and came up empty in the drive. SEVEN IN A ROW raced between horses, was floated to the five path turning for home and passed tired foes. LITTLE MISSGRIZZLY lacked speed, saved ground, was blocked leaving the far turn then passed tired horses late. MORNINGSIDEHEIGHTS , two wide between horses entering the far turn, worked between rivals and failed to be a factor. BALTIC LADY saved ground and gave way late. SCENE NOT HEARD , four wide the first turn, was fanned to the six path entering the stretch then gave way. SPHYNX KEY had speed along the rail, stopped and was pulled up late.
