Footnotes

FANCY LEAP tracked a contested pace while under rating off the inside, eased out around the turn and moved in hand to join the fray approaching the stretch, took over four wide with three sixteenths remaining, eagerly opened up under urging in mid stretch and was kept to strong pressure to the wire. CONGAREE PRINCESS, outrun early while off the rail, angled out five wide for the drive, found her best stride through the final eighth but proved no match for the winner. FALCON'S FLIGHT, rated towards the inside, was asked for run mid turn, angled out four wide in upper stretch, made a slight advance between rivals in mid stretch the flattened out late. NORTH STREET cleared early, set the pace inside then was headed approaching the half mile marker, forced the issue inside BETTERBEMONTBROOK around the turn, continued with good energy to mid stretch then faded. SEVENTH PRAYER, nudged along off the pace while two to three wide, shifted in nearing the lane and lacked a bid. BETTERBEMONTBROOK broke slowly, was sent up three wide and took command after a quarter mile, set a pressured pace in the three path around the turn, was overtaken in upper stretch and weakened leaving the three sixteenths marker.
