GIN TALKING rated close up while three wide, accelerated to the lead into the far turn, drew off and was kept to a drive. BRIG settled in mid pack down the backstretch, advanced between rivals around the final turn, chased the winner home and finished willingly. STEPPEDOUTOFADREAM saved ground in a forward position down the backstretch, angled out near the three furlong marker and lacked a stretch rally. SWEET SORROW failed to menace. SUDENLYLASTSUMMER lacked speed, raced wide into the lane and lacked a rally. HOSTA LA BYE BYE saved ground early, made a mild run between foes near the far turn and weakened. PURRFECTION PUNCH was in a bit tight leaving the gate and failed to menace. POLISH CHOICE stalked the pace four wide down the backstretch and tired. TUT TUT RAIN dueled two wide and faltered after six furlongs. BRITTANY S. dueled along the rail and stopped.
