INDIAN RESERVATION chased the pace off the rail, gained between rivals nearing the lane, shifted out five to six wide in upper stretch, responded to solid right handed pressure, moved to even terms a sixteenth out, dueled and got up late. COHEED stalked the pace two wide, quickly moved to challenge three eighths out, took over past the five sixteenths marker, kicked clear while drifting out in upper stretch, was collared near the sixteenth pole, battled inside the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. QUANTICO HERO chased the pace, was well placed towards the inside in upper stretch then lacked a solid finish. MANDATUM , urged along off the rail, rallied. DUKES FLYING TIGER lost ground five to six wide, dropped back a bit around the turn then came again willingly through the final furlong. MARIO FLOWERS , wide, had no solid run. LORD WILLING failed to menace. JOEL'S TOUCH , towards the inside, came up empty. PUSH N. BOOTS lacked speed, raced towards the inside in upper stretch and failed to menace. AUSTIN LAVIVA BABY sprinted clear early, set a brisk pace along the inside and faltered leaving the eighth pole. MYMANMAX was not a factor. SORRENTO SONG was shuffled back at the break.
