Footnotes

BORREGO'S BOY, four wide between rivals early stalking the pace, came under heavy pressure mid turn, moved to challenge a quarter mile out, forged to command approaching the eighth pole, drew away under solid handling and drifted in late. **MAGNIFICODE** took early pressure off the rail, edged clear after a half mile, was confronted by the winner leaving the five sixteenths pole, battled inside the winner from the quarter pole to mid stretch, gave way grudgingly and drifted late. **TARGET THE GOLD** bobbed at the break, moved closer under rating into the turn, angled out and worked between rivals around the turn, circled four wide into the stretch, continued progress to mid stretch then flattened out. **IRISH IDOL** prompted the pace three to four wide, came under pressure mid turn and lacked the needed finish. **JAKE'S LIL MAN**, forwardly placed under rating, angled to the rail three eighths out, had dead aim into the lane but lacked a solid response. **ROYAL LOUIE** moved up five to six wide leaving the five eighths pole, stalked into the turn, continued well wide from there, failed respond leaving the five sixteenths pole and gradually gave way. **BEST OF BRITISH** saved ground without a response. **KRUISE KONTROL**, in range to the far turn while four to five wide between rivals, dropped back.
