RICO ENDS WELL was taken back early, settled down the backstretch, angled to the seven path in upper stretch, closed determinedly under pressure, took command late and drew clear. TAMAYO was taken to rate off the rail, advanced three wide leaving the far turn, finished willingly and was clear for the place. SINGING SWORD prompted the pace two wide, took command leaving the far turn, moved clear in upper stretch, was collared a sixteenth out and faded. OH SABLE , forwardly placed under rating, moved up between rivals in mid stretch then flattened out. IDEVETER , fractious in the gate, was brushed at the start, saved ground while unhurried, angled out in upper stretch but lacked a solid response. KYRENIA settled well off the rail, was asked for run around the final turn but failed to respond. AIN'T TALKIN , bobbled at the break, set a pressured pace along the inside, dueled with SINGING SWORD approaching the quarter pole then weakened a sixteenth out.
