BASHA'S MOON moved up wide to contention entering the turn, stalked the dueling leaders three wide around the turn, forged to command near the three sixteenths marker, kicked well clear in mid stretch and maintained a safe margin under a drive. SPORTY BOY settled three wide early, gained some ground while wide around the turn, swung out five wide for the drive, made a run in mid stretch and continued willingly to save the place. JAZZ SEEKER was rated back soon after the break, saved ground into the turn, swung out six wide for the drive and rallied mildly. BALTIMORE RAVEN saved ground while within range, eased out in upper stretch, made a mild run leaving the eighth pole then flattened out. NIKEY MISSILE, between rivals around the turn, failed to respond. FRONTIER SKY prompted the early pace two wide, moved to near even terms into the turn, dueled two wide to upper stretch then weakened. SEQUINS OF EVENTS was hard used between rivals to get the early lead, dueled along the rail around the turn then faltered leaving the three sixteenths marker.
