HARD ROCKIN lacked speed, swung five wide entering the stretch, closed and drove clear. KENAHARRA , four wide turning for home, bid for the lead in midstretch and flattened out. LONESOME NUN , wide the far turn, was fanned six wide entering the lane and rallied. GLEN WILDING set a slow pace along the rail and gave way. THE REAL FUTURE , three wide the first turn, advanced four wide on the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. LADY IN ERMINE stalked the pace two wide and gave way. STAR EMERALD lacked speed and was always outrun. GILDED THREAD saved ground and stopped. SUGAR BOOGER stalked the pace three wide and stopped.
