Footnotes

ALTRUISTIC TALES, taken to rate off the rail, edged closer into the far turn, dropped to the inside entering the lane, advanced nearing the eighth pole, swung out well wide soon after, closed determinedly under pressure and got up at the wire. SIXTH AND ARCH rated in range, moved up between rivals after a half mile, angled in and chased the dueling leaders around the final turn, shifted out in upper stretch, attempted to get in some when rallying in mid stretch, straightened away while on her left lead, took command inside the sixteenth marker but was nailed at the wire. CAT N CABOODLE vied inside early, angled out past the five eighths pole, re-bid nearing the far turn, dueled to the sixteenth marker and gave way grudgingly. PRINCESS SUCREE dueled two wide early, moved clear in early backstretch, dropped to the inside, was joined by CAT N CABOODLE entering the far turn, alternated for command to the sixteenth marker and faded. CARLINGFORD broke a step slow, commenced a four to five wide run leaving the five eighths pole, loomed past the three eighths pole then flattened out. DRINK AND DIAL, unhurried early, made progress four wide nearing the quarter pole, drifted in and came up empty. WILD EXCHANGE settled inside early, angled out and circled wide the final turn but failed to respond. AUTUMN'S DISPUTE, unruly at the gate, stalked the early pace and dropped back. PLEASANTLY BLONDE failed to menace. TENACIOUS TRACI stalked the early pace, angled in and tired.
