Footnotes

ROCKABY BAY , checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, gained a three wide lead between horses after a half mile, opened up on the turn, was under brisk urging in the stretch and increased his advantage through the lane. CAJUN BAYOU , wide leaving the backstretch, chased the winner the final three furlongs and was second best. MINT MAKER saved ground, eased off the rail on the far turn, swung very wide entering the stretch and rallied mildly. PLEZE MR PRESIDENT , wide entering the stretch, rallied mildly. EZ MAC , three wide the first turn, chased the pace to the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. R. B. FLOAT saved ground around the far turn then passed tired horses. CROW'S NEST saved ground stalking the pace and gave way on the far turn. HOUND , wide both turns, was outrun. BLITZENSDISCOGETEM had speed in the two path and faltered on the far turn. ANGEL I B , three wide the first turn, dropped back leaving the backstretch.
