FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$250 to pass the entry box. \$250 additional to start with \$50,000 Guaranteed, (plus \$25,000 for Registered Maryland Breds) of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Unearned guaranteed purse money is split between the horses that start and finish the race. Supplemental nominations of \$500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at one mile or over in 2011 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs.; \$40,000 at one mile or over in 2011, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday October 13, 2011 with 26 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 70 feet).

BALTIMORE BELLE relaxed four wide in a forward position, edged closer leaving the far turn, moved to challenge after six furlongs, dueled from the quarter pole to mid stretch, responded to steady right handed encouragement and edged away late. DREAM LOUISE prompted the pace while saving ground, dropped back a bit while under pressure three furlongs out, chased the leaders into the stretch, came back along the rail in mid stretch and continued on gamely to earn the place. IN THE ROUGH tracked three wide under rating, lodged a bid between rivals mid way on the final turn, dueled to mid stretch then faded late. UNBRIDLED ESSENCE saved ground in mid pack while well off the pace, came under urging leaving the far turn, was guided out five wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed finish. AQUITAINE, unhurried early while saving ground, gained some momentum into the far turn, swung out for room leaving the three eighths pole, circled four wide into the stretch but failed to generate a solid stretch kick. FASCINATIN' RHYTHM was sent up between rivals past the wire the first turn and kicked clear entering the clubhouse turn, set a rated pace removed from the inside, took pressure past the three eighths pole, battled inside rivals to the three sixteenths marker, gave way and drifted out late. SHE BE CLASSY lagged early while saving some ground, was taken four to five wide mid way on the backstretch, made minimal progress into the far turn then lacked any further response. HERE TO WIN (BRZ) settled in the clear removed from the inside, was asked for run into the far turn, failed to respond and angled in approaching the stretch. TIMEZONE, off the rail, gave way. CHLOE CAROL saved ground and faltered after a half mile.
