COVE BAY saved ground under patient handling, eased out two wide leaving the turn, took command inside the three sixteenths pole then drew out under a hand ride. A PUBLIC AFFAIR lacked speed, circled horses and rallied. OH SO FINE showed speed along the rail and weakened. G. B'S GIRL, outrun, passed tired rivals. BUSTING raced along the rail entering the stretch and gave way. KNOCK OUT QUEEN bobbled at the break, had speed in the two path and faltered in upper stretch. ORIGINAL DIAMOND raced along the rail and faltered.
