Footnotes

KIPPERS N' EGGS saved ground setting the pace and was under urging in the drive. TERRIFFICO saved ground the first turn, eased off the rail leaving the backstretch, swung to the four path entering the stretch and rallied. SOUP D'COUPE , in the two path through the stretch, rallied between horses. DADSFOURWHEELDRIVE , between horses, passed tired ones. DAVID K , shuffled back soon after the start, rallied between horses. BRUCE ALLEY bobbled at the break, chased the pace two wide and weakened late. R. B. FLOAT , four wide the first turn, was six wide the far turn and failed to menace. DIP MY BEAK stalked the pace, moved up in the three path on the far turn and gave way in midstretch. KAPOK , between horses, failed to rally. BUBBER ,

swung to the seven path in midstretch, failed to be a factor. KIM'S DIXIE TUNE saved ground, eased off the rail entering the stretch and failed to be a factor. HOUND saved ground, chased the pace and faltered late. MY LUCA , in the seven path leaving the far turn, was outrun. PRINCE NOIR , three wide the first turn, chased the pace, drifted to the five path entering the far turn then faltered.
