Footnotes

WHERE'S DOMINIC , in range off the rail under a light hold, angled five wide into the stretch, responded when set down right handed, forged to command nearing the eighth pole, lugged in when clear and widened under a drive. PEEDS IN A POD angled off the rail in the opening sixteenth, moved two wide to draw even near the half mile marker, dueled on a short lead around the turn, was collared approaching the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. ATHABASKAN HERO stalked three to four wide, bid to challenge mid turn, dueled into the lane, held well to mid stretch and faded. IT'S MY PEROGATIVE lacked speed, angled four wide into the lane, split rivals soon after, worked further out and finished with good energy. DYNAMIC STRIKE , under the whip early while outrun, swung very wide for the drive and had some belated action. HARD TO HANDLE broke a step slow, showed a nice burst of speed inside to reach contention, tracked mid turn, angled out then back in in upper stretch and gave way. FOUR PILLARS , greenly early while under a hard ride, saved ground mid turn, angled out and gave way. MAKE MY SATURDAY broke sharply to take command, dropped to the rail, was joined after a quarter mile, dueled then tired nearing the lane. VESTRY , four wide, failed to menace. WIN WIRE saved ground around the turn, angled out and gave way. KODIAK JACK broke slowly, flashed some foot inside then dropped back.
