ACCESS TO CHARLIE tracked a contested pace, rolled up four to five wide to challenge in mid stretch, took command near the sixteenth marker and edged clear under a drive. HEIR STREAM vied inside rivals under a rating hold, drifted off the inside into the lane, met the challenge of the winner approaching the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. CARRIETTA broke slowly, was pushed along saving ground into the far turn, angled out giving chase mid turn, came six wide for the drive and rallied mildly. BANNER ELK LADY vied three wide between rivals, dropped in around the turn and lacked a bid. PARADE OF HOMES moved up five wide to engage the leaders with a half mile remaining, forced the issue around the turn and gave way in upper stretch. R U DREAMING , four and three wide battling for the early lead, gave way in upper stretch. HEAVENLY CHOIR gained a short early lead between rivals, checked and shuffled back into the turn and failed to recover. JAMRAA stumbled at the break and lost her rider.
