Footnotes

INVENT moved up under rating along the inside nearing the half mile marker, angled out three wide for the drive, moved to a short lead in midstretch, duled and was fully extended to prevail. SPARED bobbled leaving the gate, quickly recovered to prompt the pace three wide, gained command after six furlongs, was collared near the eighth pole and battled gamely inside the winner to just miss. SHADY VALLEY set the pace along the inside and weakened in upper stretch. OFF THE GLASS rushed up behind rivals and checked sharply near the six furlong marker, raced off the rail, angled five wide in upper stretch and faded. HOW PROUD lost ground three to four wide, stalked the pace for six furlongs and tired. TUFFY HACKER raced two wide and faltered after five furlongs. FULLY PACKED steadied when in tight entering the backstretch, angled to the rail, was put to stiff pressure near the half mile marker, tired and was pulled up lame a few yards from the wire.
