TRIPLE VISION stalked the duel, circled horses when taking command in upper stretch, was under brisk urging in midstretch and maintained a clear advantage the final furlong. OH WHAT A KNIGHT circled the turn, swung to the five path entering the stretch then rallied. MR. TIME TO GO broke slowly, came into the stretch in the three path, drifted in near the eighth pole, angled back out and rallied mildly. CALEB'S PRAYER saved ground, disputed the pace to midstretch then faded. IRUNALATTE, sent early, disputed the pace three wide and weakened the final furlong. HOYER saved ground and weakened through the stretch. SWEEP FIRST was outrun. SUNINYOUREYES dueled in the two path between horses and faltered in upper stretch.
