Footnotes

SCHOOL HOUSE saved ground, awaited room leaving the far turn, advanced along the rail in upper stretch, swung outside near the eighth pole, closed strongly and drove clear late. GROOVY MUSIC prompted the pace two wide, gained a short lead leaving the far turn, dueled to the sixteenth pole then weakened. BRASILIER set the pace along the rail, was engaged leaving the far turn, dueled to midstretch and gave way in the drive. FINANCIER saved ground the first turn, eased out on the far turn then had a mild rally between horses. STOCK QUOTE saved ground in a forward position, drifted off the rail entering the stretch then weakened. LEATHER GLOVES , between horses, was not a factor. HISTORY AHEAD broke slowly, raced four wide around both turns and tired in upper stretch. DIP MY BEAK , three wide both turns, prompted the pace, drifted wide in upper stretch and gave way. ILLUSTRATION bore out and soundly bumped HIGHVELDT STORM entering the first turn and faltered after five furlongs. HIGHVELDT STORM , washy going to the starting gate, was soundly bumped entering the first turn, dropped back and was eased through the stretch.
