Footnotes

PENN'S GRANT , checked a bit difficult to rate in traffic entering the first turn, worked between horses, swung to the four path in upper stretch, closed under strong riding and narrowly prevailed. EXCLUSIVE STRIKE , rated behind horses on the far turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and rallied gamely. LEIPZIG , behind horses from the head of the stretch to inside the eighth pole, swung outside near the sixteenth to finally find clear room and rallied gamely. PULPITARIAN lacked speed, swung to the nine path entering the stretch then rallied. HOB0 RIDGE disputed the pace outside ROCKABY BAY and faded in the drive. TARGET SIGHTED , angled to the eight path in upper stretch, passed tired rivals. MR. HANDSOME saved ground, stalked the pace and gave way. INCISIVE STRIKE , wide both turns, was not a factor. STRONG RESOLVE , three wide both turns, chased the pace and faltered. SYROS , very wide the far turn, was outrun. ROCKABY BAY hugged the rail, disputed the pace to upper stretch then faltered.
