HUGHES NEXT , patiently handled while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, moved between rivals mid turn, circled four wide into the stretch, closed sharply under left handed pressure, forged past CHEROKEE ARTIST nearing the sixteenth pole, was taken in hand soon after and drew out. CHEROKEE ARTIST , under snug rating while stalking the pace, moved to engage ELKHORN CREEK with a half mile remaining, took over three furlongs out, opened up a long lead in upper stretch but was simply no match. ALBRECHT , four wide the first turn, moved up three wide leaving the far turn, chased into the stretch, flattened out but did manage to save the show inside rivals. FARMER JONES , in close nearing the first turn, was steadied back from between rivals into the backstretch then lacked the needed response. JACK ARMSTRONG broke a step slow, lagged well back, circled four to five wide into the lane and had some belated action. OILTON settled back towards the inside, angled out in upper stretch and faded. SHORDAWATYADRINK was outrun. ELKHORN CREEK opened up early, set the pace inside, was joined near the half mile pole, dueled briefly, gave chase past the five sixteenths marker and faltered in upper stretch.
