BANDITS HEART broke sharply, set a rated pace slightly off the rail while taking a bit of inside pressure, dropped to the rail when clearing around the far turn, continued well within himself around the turn and into the lane, responded when set down to a drive near the eighth pole and quickly widened the final sixteenth. AVIATION SHOW saved ground while in range early, brushed with BRAD near the half mile marker, was put to a solid ride mid turn, worked outward for the stretch run and finished willingly to gain the place. DUBONNET RED prompted the early pace inside the winner, eased back and angled out, made a mild run mid turn, chased willingly to mid stretch then faded late. BOWMAN'S BOY , sluggish early, saved ground into the lane and had a decent late response. LEATHER GLOVES lost ground four wide and lacked a rally. BRAD brushed with AVIATION near the half and gave way. CULPEPPER COLONEL broke a step slow, was used wide to reach contention, chased the winner to upper stretch then retreated. LION'S CODE was through early.
