Footnotes

PASSIONATE GOLD , three wide both turns, swung out in upper stretch, closed steadily and was along in time. KEVIN'S STEEL saved ground setting the pace, raced in the two path through the stretch and gave way grudgingly. BRAMLEY stalked the pace, circled the far turn in the three path, had aim on the lead in mid stretch but flattened out between horses. NORMATIVE APPEAL saved ground stalking the pace, had room along the rail through the stretch, advanced to midstretch then came up short. WHY NOT MORE , near the rail turning for home, was behind rivals in mid stretch, altered course to the outside near the sixteenth pole and closed the gap late. I AM IRON WOMAN prompted the pace outside KEVIN'S STEEL and gave way in upper stretch. LADY CAROLYN , outrun, saved ground the far turn. CLASSICAL DESTINY was outrun. ADANNA , swung wide in upper stretch, was outrun. WONDERFUL SECRET had a shoed fixed in the paddock then weakened through the stretch.
