Footnotes

MOVING WEST stalked the pace inside horses, eased out a bid on the turn, took the lead outside ALL FOR PEACE in upper stretch, was put to brisk urging and pulled away. ALL FOR PEACE set the pace well off the rail, drifted out a bit near the quarter pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. BALTIC AVENUE saved ground on the turn, advanced into the stretch then failed to sustain his bid. CALL TO ORDER stalked the pace, raced wide around the turn and failed to rally. WOLVERTON , wide on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. BAKYT raced along the rail down the backstretch, eased out on the turn, raced very wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. DANG prompted the pace outside ALL FOR PEACE, was finished after six furlongs and faltered. DOCTOR NAIL , outrun, dropped back.
