HOUND set the pace in the two path, opened up leaving the turn and lasted under steady handling. DUDE AGAIN , two wide on the turn, angled out in midstretch and rallied between horses. VALID VENTURE lacked speed, swung to the five path entering the stretch and rallied. OUT OF OUR MINE , three wide, chased the pace and gradually weakened in the drive. LOVE TOUR , wide turning for home, weakened. VANDERKAAY lacked speed, was floated to the six path entering the stretch and was not a factor. P V LIGHTENING raced in the two path on the turn and gave way through the stretch. CALVIN K was outrun. OUR DIAMOND MINE hugged the rail, prompted the pace, stopped and was being eased late.
