RAPID REDUX broke on top then was hustled clear soon after, set the pace in the two path, was put to some hand urging leaving the far turn, met the challenge of RICH HERO three furlongs out, dug in tenaciously under strong handling the final three sixteenths and was edging away at the wire. RICH HERO broke a bit slow but quickly recovered to advance inside rivals leaving the chute, angled out leaving the three quarter pole and stalked the winner while four wide, moved up and took aim after a half mile, came under strong encouragement past the five sixteenths marker, chased into the stretch, drifted out a bit inside the furlong marker, was straightened with right handed urging and stayed on gamely. SHORDAWATYADRINK, unhurried well off the pace while saving ground, swung wide for the drive and closed belatedly. COOPER COUNTY, taken to rate early, was hard ridden three wide mid turn, chased the top pair to the head of the lane but had no stretch response. NOAH'S DREAM saved ground around the turn and failed to make an impact.
