FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$450 to pass the entry box, \$450 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed (plus \$50,000 for Registered Maryland Breds), of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Weights Three-Year-Olds 122 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 at one mile or over in 2012, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 twice at one mile or over in 2012, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 once at one mile or over in 2012, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to starters with highest career earnings in 2011-2012 on the turf. Horses may be placed on the also eligible list. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday October 18, 2012 with 39 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter).

Footnotes

DANNHAUSER saved ground stalking the pace, had room along the rail through the stretch, sprinted clear near the sixteenth pole and dug in tenaciously under brisk urging to prevail. SEE TOBE , steadied in close quarters entering the first turn, was four wide leaving the final turn, swung to the seven path in upper stretch and closed strongly. MANCHURIAN HIGH , outside horses under patient handling, was four wide on the final turn, floated to the six path in

upper stretch and rallied between horses. SLIP AND DRIVE lacked speed, was four wide leaving the final turn, advanced to midstretch then flattened out. LAKE DROP , checked in traffic near the five and a half furlongs pole, was steadied in close quarters near the half mile pole, remained between horses and lacked the needed response. ROADHOG , taken outside midway on the second turn, chased the pace four wide on the far turn and weakened in the drive. GAME BALL lacked speed, swung to the eight path in upper stretch and closed the gap late. LONDON LANE , rated back entering the first turn, was steadied along entering the second turn, angled out, advanced five wide leaving the backstretch, gained the lead in mid stretch and tired in the drive. DANCING LOUNGE , in the two path between horses the final turn, was not a factor. SIR RABBIT saved ground and was not a factor. FREUD'S HONOUR set the pace in the two path, remained prominent to mid stretch then faltered. SILVER TIE AFFAIR , wide the first turn, saved ground the final turn and faltered. NOLL WALLOP (IRE) , very wide leaving the final turn, was outrun. CONCEALED IDENTITY chased the pace outside horses and faltered.
