AH DAY stalked the pace, circled the turn, took the lead in midstretch and was put to the whip near the sixteenth pole. FORTY CROWNS disputed the pace outside TACTICAL BRUSH and faded the final furlong. TWO TERMS stalked the pace, swung wide near the quarter pole and gave way. TACTICAL BRUSH dueled along the rail and weakened. HEADSANDTALES lacked speed, raced along the rail and was not a factor. CONNECTICAT , outrun, raced wide. AMIGONI (IRE) fell back on the turn. SIR CLASSIC CHRIS , wide upper stretch, gave way.
