Footnotes

OUR NUMBER ONE sped to the front, set the pace well off the rail, opened up under brisk urging in midstretch and was relaxed late. SNEAKY LOUIS saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, angled back in in midstretch and rallied inside horses. FALCONHURST , two wide around the turn, chased the winner, raced on his left lead in the stretch and gave way. RALLY FORTH , two wide between horses on the turn, eased outside in upper stretch then failed to sustain his rally. WOODLAND FLUTE circled the turn three wide and weakened. GORB'S MARK , three wide on the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered. GENERATION SPEED hugged the rail and faltered in upper stretch. CATRIPIPI , jostled leaving the starting gate, circled the turn and was outrun.
