GREAT AZTEC , steadied after being bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced inside horses in upper stretch, angled out near the eighth pole, swept to the lead then drew out under energetic urging. ROMAN'S TOUCH , three wide on the turn, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. SPIT SPAT SPEIGHT sped to the front, set the pace off the rail and tired in the drive. ALTA BOY bore in on foes leaving the starting gate, chased the pace well off the rail and weakened. BLUE TAPE bumped with the winner leaving the starting gate, drifted out on the turn and was not a factor. CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN saved ground and was done on the turn.
