TIPPITY WITCH was unhurried early, found room along the rail entering the stretch, eased out in midstretch, closed smartly and drew out under brisk urging. SENZA PAURA prompted the pace two wide down the backstretch, opened a clear lead on the far turn and weakened inside the winner. WINDSONG saved ground to the stretch, eased out three wide in upper stretch and failed to sustain her bid. MISS CHIEF lacked speed, saved ground and passed tired foes. EL RAFFY (IRE) had speed along the rail, eased off the rail entering the stretch and gave way. DE AAR lacked speed, raced wide and passed a pair of tired horses. LIFE'S AN E TICKET stalked the pace two wide and gave way. A GIRL NEEDS CASH stalked the pace three wide and dropped back. .
