RAM , taken to rate four wide between rivals, moved closer into the lane, rallied five wide under pressure to engage the dueling leaders in mid stretch, dueled outside rivals in the final furlong and got up in the final strides. DINNY DINOSAUR prompted the pace two wide, moved between horses to challenge nearing the stretch, dueled outside AFTERNOON ACTION in upper stretch, gained a brief lead between rivals late then just missed in a game effort. BOB BOB'S BOY lost ground five to six wide, steadily advanced into the stretch and continued on willingly. AFTERNOON ACTION broke inward and was away slowly, rushed up inside rivals soon after to take command leaving the chute, set the pace along the rail, was joined nearing the lane, dueled to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. CONCEALED IDENTITY rated close up while saving ground, had dead aim off the duel into the stretch, swung out and lacked a rally. MY DIGGER , urged along mid turn, swung out five wide for the drive but failed to respond. SKIP THE TRIAL , under snug rating three wide early, moved to threaten past the three eighths pole, forced the issue into the lane then tired in the final three sixteenths. PAHINUI saved ground early, appeared to lose his action near the three eighths pole then was eased.
