Footnotes

GHOST GUNNER was angled out leaving the three quarter pole, prompted the pace three to four wide, moved in hand to collar the leader five sixteenths out, moved to command while still under rating in upper stretch, kicked clear when set down past the three sixteenths pole then turned away WIKI under strong handling. WIKI was angled out leaving the chute, settled within range while well off the rail, edged closer around the far turn, shifted out seven wide in upper stretch, finished gamely and steadily gained. BID TIL INCLUDED , unhurried early while well off the rail, gained slightly mid turn, angled extremely wide into the stretch, made a mild advance in mid stretch then flattened out. LORD KIPLING made a mild run between rivals mid turn then could not match strides through the final five sixteenths of a mile. FRED HIGH saved ground, moved to within striking distance mid way on the turn, failed to sustain and dropped back entering the stretch. LASTCALLFORDISCO cleared early, set the pace three wide into the stretch, was overtaken nearing the quarter pole and faltered soon after.
