By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$250 to pass the entry box, \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 Guaranteed, (plus \$25,000 for Registered Maryland Breds) of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Unearned guaranteed purse money is split between the horses that start and finish the race. Supplemental nominations of \$500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weights Three-Year-Olds 122 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 in 2011, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 twice 2011, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 once in 2011, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday October 20, 2011 with 20 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at Six Furlongs) (Rail at 87 feet).

BEN'S CAT chased the pace, circled the turn three wide, was fanned to the four path by ROYAL CURRIER entering the stretch, secured command near the three sixteenths pole then drew out under a mild drive. ROYAL CURRIER, sent down the backstretch, prompted the pace outside JU JITSU JAX, drifted out when taking the lead entering the stretch, drifted in in upper stretch, weakened in the drive and held the place. ACTION ANDY saved ground on the turn, eased out to the three path in upper stretch then had a mild rally between horses. MY CUZ C J, three wide between horses leaving the turn, was fanned to the four path entering the stretch then failed to sustain his bid. JU JITSU JAX sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. STEADY WARRIOR stalked the pace four wide, faltered leaving the turn and was eased late.
