Footnotes

MIKIE'S TREASURE settled early off the rail, commenced a run leaving the far turn, shifted out leaving the three sixteenths marker, closed determinedly under left handed pressure and got up at the wire. MY SWEET NENANA broke on top, set the pace along the inside, took pressure leaving the three furlong marker, responded when put to left handed urging in upper stretch, held a clear lead in mid stretch, battled gamely and was edged on the wire. BLUE DIAMOND ALLIE was sent up between rivals soon after the start, raced three wide into the backstretch, prompted the pace two wide into the far turn, lodged a bid while under a ride mid turn, forced the issue to deep stretch then was outfinished. PROM TIME settled back along the inside, made a mild run between rivals mid way on the final turn, saved ground into the stretch, had her rider lose his whip in upper stretch then rallied mildly through the final furlong. FLIP THE COIN raced between rivals nearing the far turn, came three wide for the drive and faded. COAL VALLEY was angled to the rail around the first turn, stalked the pace for a half mile then retreated leaving the far turn.
