Footnotes

R. BEE ESS eased out some nearing the turn to stalk the pace, was ridden along mid turn, lodged a bid between rivals in upper stretch to gain a slim lead, dueled past the furlong marker, switched to his right lead late and was fully extended. CAME EAST saved ground, moved closer nearing the quarter pole, eased out in upper stretch, moved between foes near the sixteenth pole then finished gamely inside the winner to just miss. CLASSIC WILDCAT , in mid pack off the rail into the turn, ranged up five wide under a ride into the stretch, bid to near even terms approaching the eighth pole, dueled briefly then hung. FLYING PUNCH , three wide nearing the turn, was ridden along around the turn, angled wider for the drive and had some belated interest. CLASS RULES sprinted clear early, set a quick pace under some rating towards the inside, was collared in upper stretch and weakened inside the furlong marker. NINIAN was outrun. IRON BULL ducked in at the break to be away slowly, was taken wide around the turn and failed to respond.
