BEN'S CAT , patiently rated, raced three wide on both turns, took the lead entering the stretch, dueled with BALTIMORE BOB through the stretch and dug in tenaciously to narrowly prevail. BALTIMORE BOB lacked speed, was kept well off the rail, moved up four wide on the far turn, reached contention in upper stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and hung. COURT BAND , unhurried, raced five wide turning for home and rallied. SCATTER THE TAK set the pace in the two path and weakened through the stretch. SARTO stalked the pace between horses and weakened. LUCKY WILL stalked the pace, raced wide the far turn and gave way. SANDBAGIN' LOVER saved ground stalking the pace and gave way.
